CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

The defendant's release on bond is subject to the following conditions:


1. Collateral bonds on Defendant's home,
2. Defendant will participate in the home detention program under the supervision of the United States Pretrial Services for the Northern District of California ("Pretrial Services");
3. Defendant is required to submit to both electronic location monitoring ("LM") and global positioning system ("GPS") monitoring;
4. Defendant will be responsible for the cost of both the LM and GPS monitoring;
5. Defendant will keep the LM and GPS equipment properly charged and maintain it in accordance with the directions she will be given;
6. Defendant will wear the LM ankle bracelet at all times and carry the GPS monitor with her to enable appropriate monitoring by Pretrial Services, or its vendor, and agrees not to tamper with or remove either of them for any reason without authorization;
7. Pretrial Services shall arrange for its LM and GPS monitoring vendor to directly notify Department of Commerce Special Agent Pat Tinling and Special Agent in Charge Julie Salcido and Supervisory Deputy United States Marshal Michael Dyke immediately upon receipt of an infraction or possible infraction of these release conditions by Dr. Wang, whenever it may occur, seven days a week, 24 hours a day;
8. If Pretrial Services is alerted or notified during business hours of any infraction or possible infraction by Dr. Wang, a representative of Pretrial Services shall immediately call Chambers of the undersigned (202-354-3260) and shall immediately coordinate with Special Agent Pat Tinling and Special Agent in Charge Julie Salcido and Supervisory Deputy United States Marshal Michael Dyke;
9. Upon a showing of probable cause that there has been a violation of the Court's Order, any federal law enforcement officer is authorized to take Dr. Wang into immediate custody and to seek her immediate removal to this Court and detention without bond pending that removal;
10. Defendant may leave her home for medical and legal appointments, appearances in this District, and activities at her daughter's school, all of which must be pre-approved by Pretrial Services;
11. Defendant is expressly prohibited from entering or being within 1,000 feet of any airport, except for pre-approved travel as discussed above, or any embassy or consulate;

12. Any travel to the District of Columbia for legal appointments or appearances in this District shall be pre-approved by Pretrial Services in California and coordinated with Pretrial Services for the District of Columbia within at least one business day of travel;
13. When Defendant is in the District of Columbia, Defendant shall notify Pretrial Services in the District of Columbia (Patty Sucato, 202-442-1000) and shall submit to placement on GPS monitoring while in the District of Columbia;
14. Defendant is prohibited from leaving the United States;
15. Defendant shall surrender her passport and green card to Pretrial Services in the Northern District of California and shall not apply for or possess any passports;
16. Defendant's husband shall surrender his passport to Pretrial Services in the Northern District of California and shall not apply for or possess any passports;
17. Once Defendant's minor daughter returns from her planned trip to Alaska at the end of this month, her daughter shall surrender her passport to Pretrial Services in the Northern District of California and shall not apply for or possess any passports;
18. Defendant will waive any right not to be extradited to the United States should the issue of extradition arise.
